Step 1. Get Ready to Apply

Applicants must meet all the following requirements to apply:

- □ Be at least 18 years of age
- □ Have either a high school diploma or GED
- □ Have a valid California ID or California Driver's License (required to be presented by applicant at the time of their scheduled Wonderlic Assessment Exam)

Step 2. Complete the Online Application

 - Letters must bear the original signature and be dated within 6 months of your application

 - o Applicant's Resume (1-2 pages)

Step 3. Submit your Official Transcript(s)

- Foreign Diplomas and Transcripts: All foreign diplomas and transcripts must include an official notarized translation in English and be evaluated by a foreign transcript evaluation agency (NACES) prior to submission.
- High school diplomas, photocopies or faxed copies of transcripts will not be accepted.
- Official Transcripts must be unopened and received in their original sealed envelopes.

Step 4. The Wonderlic Assessment Exam

- Applicants must have completed the online application process, submitted supporting documents, submitted official transcript(s), and paid their application handling fee* by the application deadline to be considered eligible to take the Wonderlic Assessment Exam.
- Eligible applicants will be contacted by email to schedule their Wonderlic Assessment Exam appointment. Exam appointments will be scheduled after the close of the application period.
