- A completed application includes the following:
- Submitted online application.
- Valid CPR card. The CPR card must be valid through the completion of the program. KPSAHS will not accept any other type of CPR certification. American Heart Association only. **No Copies of cards will be accepted. Must submit original card**.
- Application Handling Fee of \$65.00 (**non-refundable**) via PayPal once you have completed your online application.
- Official Sealed Transcripts: All foreign diplomas and documents must include an official notarized translation in English and be evaluated by a foreign transcript evaluation agency prior to submission. <u>Photocopies are not accepted.</u>

Applications received without payment and or supporting documents by the application deadline will be processed as incomplete.
